THE KASHMIR CONFLICT

s long as the territory's existence was guaranteed by the United Kingdom, the weaknesses in its structure and along its peripheries were not of great consequence, but they became apparent after the British withdrawal from South Asia in 1947. By the terms agreed to by India and Pakistan for the partition of the Indian subcontinent, the rulers of princely states were given the right to opt for either Pakistan or India or-with certain reservations-to remain independent. Hari Singh, the maharaja of Kashmir, initially believed that by delaying his decision he could maintain the independence of Kashmir, but, caught up in a train of events that included a revolution among his Muslim subjects along the western borders of the state and the intervention of Pashtun tribesmen, he signed an Instrument of Accession to the Indian union in October 1947. This was the signal for intervention both by Pakistan, which considered the state to be a natural extension of Pakistan, and by India, which intended to confirm the act of accession. Localized warfare continued during 1948 and ended, through the intercession of the United Nations, in a cease-fire that took effect in January 1949. In July of that year, India and Pakistan defined a cease-fire line-the line of control-that divided the administration of the territory. Regarded at the time as a temporary expedient, the partition along that line still exists. Attempts at resolution and legitimization

Although there was a clear Muslim majority in Kashmir before the 1947 partition, and its economic, cultural, and geographic contiguity with the Muslim-majority area of the Punjab could be convincingly demonstrated, the political developments during and after the partition resulted in a division of the region. Pakistan was left with territory that, although basically Muslim in character, was thinly populated, relatively inaccessible, and economically underdeveloped. The largest Muslim group, situated in the Vale of Kashmir and estimated to number more than half the population of the entire region, lay in Indian-administered territory, with its former outlets via the Jhelum valley route blocked.

Many proposals were subsequently made to end the dispute over Kashmir, but tensions mounted between the two countries following the Chinese incursion into Ladakh in 1962, and warfare broke out between India and Pakistan in 1965. A cease-fire was established in September, followed by an agreement signed by the two sides at Tashkent (Uzbekistan) in early January 1966, in which they resolved to try to end the dispute by peaceful means. Fighting again flared up between the two in 1971 as part of the India-Pakistan war that resulted in the creation of Bangladesh. An accord signed in the Indian city of Shimla in 1972 expressed the hope that henceforth the countries in the region would be able to live in peace with each other.

A number of movements have variously sought a merger of Kashmir with Pakistan or independence for the region from both India and Pakistan. To contend with these movements and confront Pakistani forces along the ceasefire line, the Indian union government has maintained a strong military presence there, especially since the end of the 1980s. Until 2019 the military presence was also intended to support the administrative integrity of Jammu and Kashmir state from movements seeking Indian union territory status for Buddhist Ladakh. Insurgency and counterinsurgency Disillusioned with lack of progress through the democratic process, armed freedom fighter organizations began to pop up in the region in the late 1980s. Their purpose was to resist control from the Indian union government and pave way for the UN guaranteed Right of self-determination.

Shelling across the line of control has continued intermittently into the early 21st century, until a cease-fire agreement was reached in 2004. Limited passenger bus service began in 2005 between Srinagar and Muzaffarabad on either side of the frontier, and, after the devastating earthquake in the region later that year, India and Pakistan allowed survivors and trucks carrying relief supplies to cross at several points along the line of control. In addition, in 2008 both countries opened cross-border trade links through the Kashmir region for the first time since the 1947 partition; trucks carrying locally produced goods and manufactures began operating between Srinagar and Muzaffarabad and between Rawalkot, Pakistan, and Punch, India.

Despite these advances, tensions have continued to erupt periodically in the region. Prolonged violent protests flared up over control of a piece of land used by Hindu pilgrims visiting the Amarnath cave shrine east of Srinagar in 2008 and again in 2010 after Indian soldiers killed three Pakistani villagers who they claimed were armed freedom fighters trying to infiltrate across the line of control. A subsequent investigation revealed that the soldiers had in fact lured the men to the area and murdered them in cold blood.

Another cycle of unrest began after the Hindu nationalist Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) swept elections across India in 2014. The party had won an outright majority in the national legislature and began pushing policies nationwide to promote hindutva ("Hindu-ness"). The BJP, which strongly favoured the union of Kashmir with India, had become the second largest party in the Jammu and Kashmir Legislative Assembly and formed a unity government with the slightly larger People's Democratic Party (PDP), whose platform centred on the implementation of selfrule in Kashmir. As the hindutva and pro-India policies of the BJP stoked the anxieties of the region's predominantly Muslim population, Kashmir saw an uptick in unrest. The growing tensions erupted into rioting in July 2016 after the indigenous Kashmiri Youth was killed in an operation by Indian forces. India's union government, dominated by the BJP, began asserting increased control over the state as a matter of national security and launched a crackdown on armed freedom fighters. In late 2018 the union government dissolved the government of Jammu and Kashmir and began direct rule of the state after the BJP left the state's unity coalition and caused its collapse.

As the BJP continued along its forceful push in Jammu and Kashmir, the union government in August built up its military presence in the state and within days undertook action to formalize its direct control there. Exploiting a constitutional provision that allowed the union government to integrate Jammu and Kashmir upon the approval of a no-longer-extant elected body, it suspended Jammu and Kashmir's autonomy and applied India's constitution fully to the territory. It also passed legislation to downgrade the state in October to a union territory—thereby allowing the union government full control over its governance—and to split off the Ladakh region into a separate union territory of its own

I have always advocated that standing together, we can work for Kashmir 365 days a year. The impact of working together and in unison was clearly depicted when KYA became the focal face of the largest Flag draped in Islamabad as well as when the book launch ceremony of Baang was executed in the Aiwan e Sadr.

I pray that KYA keeps on blooming, staying true to its manifesto and becoming a voice of the unheard. In my personal capacity, I will always be a soldier of the Kashmir Cause regardless of where the future takes me. Being the brother of a martyr, Nephew of Syeda Asiya Andrabi and Dr Qasim Factoo, from the family of Syed Ali Geelani, I also take Pride and will continue to do so that I served KYA as its President.

May ALLAH dawn the Sun of Freedom upon the Kashmiris soon and may they breathe in the free air with no oppression or colonial imperialism against them.

DR. MUHAMMAD QASIM FAKTOO

orn in 1967, Aashiq Hussain Factoo aka Dr. Muhammad Qasim, was among the ambitious young men who wanted to excel in education and status. However, as Indian colonial mindset got completely exposed in 1987, Dr Qasim joined the resistance movement camp. Aasiya Andrabi married Dr Qasim Faktoo in 1990 – Dr. Qasim himself is a Hurriyat Leader and Freedom fighter and one of the top most scholars in Indian Occupied Jammu & Kashmir. He is the longest unjustified held prisoner of IIOJK since 1993. The couple spent only two years together of their married life and has two children, Muhammad and Ahmad who were raised mostly with their parents behind bars.

Dr. Muhammad Qasim Faktoo, known for being the scholarly edifice of Indian Occupied Kashmir, is languishing behind bars for 28 years now. He is the only person who completed PhD behind bars. Booked U/S 3 TADA and RPC, The court released him on bail for 6 months in 1999. This was challenged by Indian Government and the puppet courts sentenced Dr. Qasim for life imprisonment. The only evidence against him is the confessional statement given by him under duress. These 29 years mark the injustice and biased law system of India and its puppet courts in Kashmir, where the definition of life imprisonment has been changed to imprisonment till death only in this specific case.Despite all laws and human rights support in his favor, He is still in jail. A victim of Political Vendetta, he was subjected to extreme inhuman torture in the name-dread torture cells of Indian Held Kashmir. A detailed version of his ailments is being described.

During his incarceration, the third degree torture resulted in bodily weaknesses and imbalance in walking. The physical torture has led to dislocation of discs that is aggravating further due to non-facility of disc friendly bedding in jail. The biggest problem with Dr Qasim is of his eyesight. Being in Jail persistently has dimmed his physical vision to a level of near blindness. The Eye pressure and Claucoma is so extensive that doctors have suggested him a complete rest to eyes. However, this Scholar has authored 19 books till now and the honorable work is going on despite of such a grave eyesight problem.

Arif Alvi PAYS HOMAGE TO Dr Muhammad Qasim Faktoo

n 5th January 2022, International Day of Self Determination, Kashmir Youth Alliance in collaboration with Parliamentary Committee on Kashmir organized launching ceremony of a book "Ba'ang" authored by Dr Qasim Faktoo, who is serving life imprisonment till death in an Indian Jail.

He said the unending oppression coupled with atrocities and human rights violations committed against the innocent Kashmiris in the Indian illegally occupied Jammu and Kashmir (IIOJK) and other minorities in India, were resulting in a fire that would eventually engulf India and dawn into the freedom of the Kashmiri people.



The book launching ceremony was held at President House Islamabad and was presided over by President Islamic Republic of Pakistan, Dr. Arif Alvi. Chairman Parliamentary Committee on Kashmir Shehryar Khan Afridi, Son of Dr Qasim Faktoo & Asiya Andrabi, Ahmed bin Qasim, President Kashmir Youth Alliance Dr Syed Mujahid Gilani, and Renowned Current Affairs Anchor Imran Riaz Khan also addressed the gathering.

In his address President Dr. Arif Alvi said India was on the path to self-destruction with its Hindutva policy. India is targeting all minorities as it is vainly planning to suppress the Kashmiris' struggle for their right to self-determination with barbaric steps.



The president regretted that the world was driven through its priorities and vested interests like trade and economy, and was neglecting humanity. He also reiterated that Pakistan being a morality-based country would continue extending its moral, diplomatic and political support to the Kashmiri people in their just struggle for the right to self-determination.

Chairman Parliamentary Committee on Kashmir Shehryar Khan Afridi said "The sacrifices of Kashmiri leaders like Dr. Qasim would ultimately result in the freedom of the IIOJK from the Indian occupation. He also stressed that raising the IIOJK issue at the global forums through collective efforts is the need of hour." He urged the world community to take notice of the travesty of justice being committed by Indian forces

against the political prisoners of Indian Illegally Occupied Jammu and Kashmir (IIOJK).

Dr Qasim Faktoo's son Ahmed bin Qasim said Dr. Faktoo's book 'Ba'ang' provides an insight into his sufferings and life-long struggle against the Indian illegal occupation of Jammu and Kashmir. "My father was arrested in 1993 at the Srinagar Airport, along with my mother and older brother, Muhammad, who was a few months old at the time. He spent six



months in prison, making him the youngest political prisoner of the Kashmir conflict." he added.

MUHAMMAD ASHRAFKHAN SEHRAI

uhammad Ashraf Khan Sehrai, Hurriyat Leader and a close companion of Syed Ali Geelani, was born in Tekipora (Lolab) in Kupwara in 1944. Sehrai did his basic schooling from a local school in his village and passed his tenth class from Government High School Sogam. He was appointed as a teacher in Darasgahi Islami now called Islamia High School Lalpora. Sehrai had survived 14 years of his age in different jails within and outside Jammu and Kashmir. For the first time, he was jailed in 1965.

In his early age he was appointed as Qaim-i-Zila, deputy head of Baramulla district by Jamaat Islami. After many years when Geelani became the Memof Legislative ber Assembly (MLA) Sopore constit-Sehrai become head of the trict. Sehrai was children, includtwo daughters. Junaid Ashraf by Indian Forc-Sehraie 1975, sembly elections in opposition to Mohammad Ab-

lah. Sehrai was

among various who were detained during the state-wide lockdown imposed to revoke the special status of Jammu and Kashmir. Later in July 2020, he was arrested from his Baghat residence in Srinagar by the Indian Police under the Black law named Jammu and Kashmir Public Safety Act (PSA). While being behind the bars in Udhampur jail, his health started deteriorating in the later years. Eventually, he was shifted to Government Medical College Jammu for treatment on May 4,2021. A day later, he breathed his last in Jammu hospital. According to reports by Indian Sources, he was Covid-19 positive. His Oxygen level, one report said had dipped to 60. Sehrai's family alleged that he was "murdered" by the authorities, while the Jammu and Kashmir High Court Bar Association alleges his death was a "custodial murder".

"AIK SHAHEED AIK SHAJAR" Countrywide Campaign

n Aug 5, 2021, Kashmir Youth Alliance in collaboration with Parliamentary Committee on Kashmir started a countrywide campaign titled "Aik Shaheed, Aik Shajar" to pay tribute to Martyrs of Indian Occupied Jammu and Kashmir.

In Inauguration Ceremony at National Assembly of Pakistan Chairman Shehryar Khan Afridi planted a sapling at Parliament House to pay homage to Ashraf Khan Sehrai Shaheed & other Kashmiri martyrs. President Kashmir Youth Alliance Dr Syed Mujahid Gilani, Secretary General KYA Razi Tahir also joined the event.

Shehryar Khan Afridi said "Sehrai's custodial killing demonstrates that Indian occupational regime is adamant to use all available tools to subjugate the people of IIOJK into submission but the sacrifices of Sehrai testifies that no matter what, India can never break the will of the Kashmiri leadership".

Dr Syed Mujahid Gilani said We will do "Aik Shaheed, Aik Shajar" Campaign annually in plantation season. Volunteers of Kashmir Youth Alliance planted more than 5000 plants across the Country, named after the Martyrs of Indian Illegaly Occupied Jammu Kashmir. Leader KYA Dr Abdullah Khalil planted 1000+ plants in Islamabad and distributed them in Islamabad rural areas.

Tribal Youth Forum organized plantation activity at Bajaur while Secretary General KYA Razi Tahir headed plantation campaign in District Attock.







NA unanimously adopts motion demanding India reverse annexation of JAMMU AND KASHMIR

n 4th Feb 2020, On Special Request of Dr. Syed Mujahid Gilani, President KYA, National Assembly Included various Hurriyat Leader's names in the resolution for the first time in the history. A delegation of Kashmir Youth Alliance headed by Dr. Syed Mujahid Gilani; Asiya Andrabi's Son Ahmed bin Qasim attended the session.

Speaker NA welcomed Ahmad Bin Qasim, Son of Mohtarma Asiya Andrabi and Dr. Mujahid Gilani, nephew of Mohtarma Asiya Andrabi. They witnessed the proceedings of the House from the Speaker's Gallery.

Chairman of Parliamentary Committee on Kashmir Syed Fakhar Imam tabled the resolution in the assembly. National Assembly Expressed concerns at the illegal detention and prolonged incarceration of political leaders from different political parties, particularly the Kashmiri Hurriyat leaders like Yasin Malik, Shabbir Shah who was first arrested when he was

14 years old and kept behind bars on and off, presently more than 65 years of age and still in Jail, Syeda Asiya Andrabi kept behind bars for 11 years collectively, Syed Ali Gilani house arrested and Mirwaiz Umar Farooq house arrested, Dr. Qasim Faktu behind bars for 27 long years on a stretch, Masrat Alam in Jail for more than 20 years and many such more political prisoners.

The resolution also denounced violence against women by the Indian forces, "especially the use of rape as a weapon of war" as well as the "deliberate targeting of civilian population" in ceasefire violations. It also noted with concern the continued lockdown in occupied Kashmir and deployment of more troops in the territory. The resolution also focused on India's "strong-arm tactics" to change the ethnic demography of the region.

After the Session, KYA delegation met Fakhar Imam, Chairman Parliamentary Kashmir Committee and thanked him.



IRON LADY OF KASHMIR

ndrabi, Born in early 1960s, is one of the leading Hurriyat leader and the true free female voice of Kashmir. Attaining her graduation in Biochemistry, nutrition and child development and Masters in Arabic from KU, the then young and ambitious college girl transformed into an Islamic and social reformist in mid 80s. She laid the foundation of Dukhtaran-e-Millat that is termed as the biggest women outfit in the freedom movement of Indian Held Kashmir. DeM has undertaken a number of social reforms including the establishment and successful running of girls' schools as well as raising voice over the brutal barbaric atrocities committed by the Indian forces.

Andrabi married Ashiq Hussain Faktoo AKA Dr. Muhammad Qasim in 1990–Dr. Qasim himself is a freedom fighter and one of the top most scholars in iok. He is the longest unjustified held prisoner of ioK since 1993. The couple spent only two years together of their married life and has two children, Muhammad and Ahmad who were raised mostly with their parents behind bars.

Asiya was arrested in 1993 for the first time and has eversince faced incarceration on and off. In 2010, she was taken in for two consecutive years and in 2015-2016 she was booked under PSA for unfurling the Pakistan flag. Aasiya, the brave lady, was subjected to inhalant smoke continuously during her captivity that resulted in severe lung damage and dependence on medications.

In the Kashmir uprising-2016, she played a major role in arranging women protests. She was arrested in Oct 2016 again till January 2017 only to be re-arrested again However, 2017 marked her incarceration year and she was kept behind bars, away from Srinagar, in the torture cell of Amphala, Jammu.

On the 1st April, 2018, Andrabi sent a voice message to the Power holders of Pakistan against the Shopian Massacre of youth. Her message was received well and GOP declared special black day. Aasiya Anrdrabi was arrested just 20 days after under FIR for unfurling Pakistani Flag. She was shifted in July 2018 from Srinagar Central to Tihar Jail in Delhi under fake allegations by NIA.


Freedom from Indian Occupation is our Destiny Syeda Aasiya Andrabi Telephonic Press Conference

n 5th Feb 2017, Kashmir Youth Alliance arranged a Press Conference to convey the message of Chief Dukhtran e Millat Mohtarma Syeda Aasiya Andrabi to Pakistanis. In her telephonic address, she said "My Heart and Soul is in Pakistan" and freedom from Indian Occupation is our destiny.

She highlighted the issues of half widows' and said "our women do not know whether their husbands will return or not". When our children and men leave their homes every day, they do not know that they will return alive or as dead bodies". She added.

She called upon the international community, including the United Nations, world parliaments, international human rights and humanitarian organizations, and global media to take immediate action for providing right to self-determination to people of Indian Occupied Kashmir.







yed Ali Geelani was born on Sept. 29, 1929 in a village on the banks of Wular lake in Sopore area of Kashmir's Baramulla district. After early education in his home town, he traveled to Lahore -- then a hub of literary activities -- for higher studies.

SYED

He returned to Srinagar after finishing his degree in Islamic theology in 1940s. He also studied Islamic jurisprudence, besides Urdu and Persian. In 1949, while teaching at a public school, he joined Jamat e Islami, and become Nazim of Kupwara and Baramulla districts. He was first arrested in 1962 on the charges of "raising the Kashmir issue," and remained incarcerated for about 13 months. He was again arrested in 1965, spending 22 months in jail. In addition, he had to endure the hardships of detention and arrest from time to time until his death.

In 1969, He won from his home constituency in Sopore, and entered the provincial assembly. He won the 1977 elections as well but lost in 1983, and was made the party's parliamentary affairs secretary. In 1992, foundation of All Parties Hurriyat (Freedom) Conference (APHC) was laid. It was a platform of at least 30 pro-freedom parties to take forward Kashmir's fight for right to self-determination. The Jel was represented by Geelani.

In August 2004, Geelani along with his life-time associate, Muhammad Ashraf Sehrai, launched Tehreek-e-Hurriyat (Movement of Freedom). He authored at least 30 books including his autobiography 'Wular Kinaray or Around the banks of Wular lake'; his jail dairy besides his commentary in Urdu on Persian poetry of Pakistan ideological founder, Muhammad Iqbal.

On 14 August 2020, Pakistani President Arif Alvi conferred Nishan-e-Pakistan, Pakistan's highest civil award on Geelani to recognise his decades-long struggle for Kashmiris' right to self-determination.

Syed Ali Geelani was elected as Chairman APHC and remained his position till a year before his death. He reportedly developed breathing complications and died on 1 September 2021 at his Hyderpora residence in Srinagar secondary to his prolonged illness. The police forcibly took away his body and buried it, while his family was refused to attend the funeral.

n 16th September 2021, Kashmir Society of GCU Lahore organized Condolence Reference for the late Syed Ali Geelani. Governor Punjab Chaudhary Muhammad Sarwar was the Chief Guest. Vice Chancellor Prof. Dr. Asghar Zaidi, Dr. Syed Mujahid Gilani, President Kashmir Youth Alliance (KYA), eminent journalist Salman Ghani, Taha Muneeb Senior Vice President KYA and Razi Tahir Secretary General KYA were also present.


Punjab Governor Chaudhry Mohammad Sarwar announced establishment of a research chair at the Government College University Lahore in the name of the late Syed Ali Shah Geelani, the veteran Kashmiri resistance leader and former chief of the All Parties Hurriyat Conference.

Sarwar paid tribute to the courageous struggle of Mr. Geelani, saying that he had struggled all his life for his people and their right to self-determination. He said Geelani was an uncompromising campaigner against Indian rule in Kashmir, and he devoted his entire life to the freedom of Kashmiris.

President Kashmir Youth Alliance Dr Syed Mujahid Gilani highlighted Geelani's decades-long struggle for Kashmiris' right to self-determination, saying that the great Kashmiri leader suffered incarceration and torture by the occupying Indian state but remained resolute. "Syed Ali Geelani always looked in the eyes of enemy and loudly said we are Pakistan and Pakistan is ours," he added.

The participants prayed for Syed Ali Geelani and conveyed their condolences to his family.



BUREAU MUZAFFAR WANI

urhan Muzaffar Wani was born on September 19, 1994 at Dadsara village of Tral area of Pulwama. Both his father and mother were teachers at government schools in Tral. Burhan is survived by two younger brothers and a sister.

Burhan joined the armed struggle on October 16, 2010. The driving force of his joining the military resistance was to avenge the humiliation caused when he was severely beaten by Indian troops along with his brother Khalid Muzaffar Wani, who was later martyred by the Indian army in custody on April 13, 2015 for meeting Burhan in Tral forest.

Since 2011, Burhan was popular on social media as a commander of the largest indigenous Kashmiri freedom fighters organization -- Hizbul Mujahideen. He used the latest technology and the internet to promote Kashmiri cause on social media that sent shock waves across top ranks of the Indian army in New Delhi and gave sleepless nights to the New Delhi's security establishment for more than six years.

Burhan was a smart Kashmiri freedom fighter with political guts and was completely following the line of the All Parties Hurriyat Conference (APHC) to promote Kashmiri's struggle. The Indian army along with other security agencies martyred Burhan Wani and his two colleagues -- Sartaj Ahmad Sheikh and Pervaiz Ahmad Lashkari -- at Bumdoora village in Kokernag area on July 8, 2016.

More than one million people gathered at Eidgah Tral and offered 40 funerals of Burhan. He was laid to rest close to the grave of his elder brother Khalid Muzafar Wani.

BURHAN WANI A Symbol of Freedom Beyond Kashmir's Boundaries Masood Khan

n 24th January 2020, Kashmir Youth Alliance organized Q&A session with the President Azad Jammu and Kashmir Sardar Masood Khan, which was aired on 26th January on Pakistan Television News. Makhdoom Shahab Ud Din and Razi Tahir were the hosts.

The AJK president underlined that the struggle for Kashmir's freedom must be carried forward with strong determination, hope and strength. He said that the people of Jammu and Kashmir have been sacrificing their lives since 1947 and similarly Pakistan has been paying the cost of its support to Kashmir cause for the past seven decades.





In response to a question by a student, he clearly stated that all freedom fighters including Burhan Muzaffar Wani are our heroes. Wani is an Icon for Kashmiri Youth and they are following his path.

He also voiced his grave concerns over the continued detention of Kashmiri leaders and called upon the world human rights bodies to play their role in the early release of Kashmiri prisoners who had been arrested under the black laws of PSA and AFSPA.

MASARAT ALAM BHAT

Masarat Alam Bhat born 1971 is a Kashmiri Huriyat Leader and Chairman of the Jammu Kashmir Muslim League. He was appointed as chairman of Hurriyat Conference after the death of Syed Ali Geelani. He played a significant role in the 2010 Kashmir stone pelting rallies which broke out against the Machil encounter carried out by the Indian Army in Occupied Kashmir. Government has booked Masrat Alam in 27 fake criminal cases but in most of these he has either been exonerated or bailed out by the courts. He has been jailed for 17 years and has around 27 cases against him. He has been slapped with the maximum number of PSA's against him with no conviction in any case till now.



YASIN MALIK

Yasin Malik. born 1966 is a Kashmiri Hurriyat Leader and Freedom Fighter who advocates the Independent Kashmir. He is currently lodged in Tihar jail. He is the Chairman of Jammu Kashmir Liberation Front. In recent times, Malik has had oneon-one meetings with President of Pakistan, Prime Minister of Pakistan, Prime Minister of India and other world leaders. In 2007, Malik and his party launched a campaign known as Safar-i-Azadi (Journey of Freedom). During this time Yasin Malik and his colleagues visited about 3,500 towns and villages of Kashmir promoting & advocating right to self-determination.



SHABIR AHMED SHAH

Shabir Ahmad Shah born 14 June 1953, in Kadipora, Anantnag, Kashmir is the founder and president of the Jammu and Kashmir Democratic Freedom Party (JKDFP), one of the main pro-freedom political organizations seeking "right of self-determination" to Jammu and Kashmir. He also served as Secretary General of Tehreek e Hurriyat, led by Syed Ali Geelani. Having spent 32 years of his life in jails, he is known as the "Jail Bird" and recognized by Amnesty International as "The Prisoner of Conscience."

Shehryar draws world attention to **travesty** of **justice** in **IIOJK**

n 15th January 2019, Volunteers Force Pakistan (YFP) and Kashmir Youth Alliance (KYA) organized Volunteer Peace Conference at President House, Muzaffarabad, Azad Jammu and Kashmir (AJK), presided over by Sardar Masood Khan, President AJK.


DC Islamabad HAMZA SHAFQAAT hosted KYA General Body Meeting











WEBINARS & WITTER ACTIV







